On 07/15/12 at approximately 0051 hrs, units responded to 713 Marietta St. in reference to a battery in progress. The caller advised dispatch that there were several subjects outside fighting at that location. When asked how many, the caller said approximately 4 subjects. The caller also advised dispatch that there was a silver in color Chevy truck and a motorcycle in the yard. The caller advised dispatch that she did not see any weapons.

Ofc. Blanton arrived on scene and made contact with a witness, Kenneth Edwards, who advised Ofc. Blanton that the Chevy truck and the motorcycle headed south bound on Marietta St. and turned right. Ofc. Blanton looked toward W. Dixie Ave and he observed the truck and motorcycle heading east bound on W. Dixie Ave, Ofc. Blanton advised units of the direction of travel over the main police radio channel.

Cpl. Sparkman located the motorcycle and Chevy truck on Dixie Ave. Cpl. Sparkman performed a traffic stop on the Chevy truck in the area of Rambo St. and E. Dixie Ave. and made contact with the driver, Anthony Rodriguez. Sr. Ofc. Thomas arrived as a back-up unit and assisted Cpl. Sparkman. (See Cpl. Sparkman and Sr. Ofc. Thomas' supplements for further)

Sgt. Stewart was behind Cpl. Sparkman and she continued to follow the motorcycle on E. Dixie Ave. Sgt. Stewart attempted to stop the motorcycle in the area of E. Dixie Ave and Main St. The driver of the motorcycle, later identified as Jonathan Brown, looked back at Sgt. Stewart, turned right onto south bound US Hwy 441 and fled the area at a high rate of speed. Sgt. Stewart gave the direction of travel of the motorcycle over main police radio channel and continued to drive south bound on US Hwy 441. Sgt. Stewart then observed a Lake County Sheriffs Deputy traveling south bound on US Hwy 441 with his over headlight on. Sgt. Stewart observed the deputy turning left onto SR 44. (See Sgt. Stewart's supplement)

Ofc. Blanton asked Mr. Edwards what happened and he stated the following:

Mr. Edwards was walking north bound on Marietta St and observed 3 individuals fighting in front of 713 Marietta St. As Mr. Edwards approached the individuals, he saw that two subjects were on top of another individual, repeatedly striking him. As Mr. Edwards got closer to the subjects, he observed the Mr. Rodriguez holding Mr. Jackson down on the ground. Mr. Brown stood up and picked up a cinder block that was lying on the ground next to them. Mr. Brown raised the cinder block in his hands about chest high. Mr. Brown then held the cinder block over Mr. Jackson's head as if he were going to hit him on the head with it. Mr. Edwards called out to Mr. Jackson and asked if he needed help. Mr. Brown and Mr. Rodriguez heard and then saw Mr. Edwards. Mr. Brown dropped the cinder block on the ground. Mr. Brown ran and got on the motorcycle and the Mr. Rodriguez ran and got into the Chevy truck. Mr. Brown and Mr. Rodriguez fled the scene south bound on Marietta St.

It was determined that Mr. Edwards was an independent witness who did not have any affiliation with either party involved in the incident.

Ofc. Blanton then made contact with Mr. Jackson who stated the following:

Mr. Jackson was walking up the steps to the front door of his residence when he heard someone yell at him. Mr. Jackson looked toward the street and observed a gold or silver in color Chevy Silverado and a motorcycle parked on the street and Mr. Brown and Mr. Rodriguez were walking toward his residence. Mr. Rodriguez asked Mr. Jackson where Mr. Jackson's girlfriend was and Mr. Jackson replied that she was in her vehicle in the backyard and was leaving the residence. Mr. Jackson walked toward Mr. Brown and Mr. Rodriguez and they began to argue in the front yard. Mr. Rodriguez then punched Mr. Jackson and they all began to fight. Mr. Brown broke away from the fight and grabbed a cinder block that was in the front yard of Mr. Jackson's residence. Mr. Brown held the cinder block about chest high and Mr. Jackson thought that Mr. Brown was going to hit him on the head with the cinder block. Mr. Edwards asked Mr. Jackson if he needed help and Mr. Brown dropped the cinder block on the ground. Mr. Brown and Mr. Rodriguez ran toward their vehicles and left the area.

Ofc. Blanton asked for EMS to respond to the scene to treat Mr. Jackson. Lake EMS arrived on scene and Mr. Jackson refused treatment. (Lake EMS Run # 23434)

While on scene, Sgt. Stewart was informed by the Lake County Sheriffs Office that they had located Mr. Brown's motorcycle parked in the Blueberry Hill Apartment complex near 33316 Ryan Dr. Sgt. Stewart was also advised that a separate incident occurred while they were looking for Mr. Brown in which shots were fired. (Lake County Case # 1201-01704)

I arrived on scene at approximately 0217 hrs and I made contact with Mr. Jackson. I observed two lacerations and swelling to Mr. Jackson's right eye. I also observed swelling to Mr. Jackson left eye, abrasions to both of Mr. Jackson's elbows, an abrasion on his left knee and an abrasion on his left ankle.

I looked in the area where the incident occurred and I observed blood on the sidewalk. I also observed a cinder block on the grass approximately two feet away from the blood.

I then made contact with Mr. Jackson's's girlfriend, Megan Smalt, who advised the following:

On 07/14/12, Mr. Jackson and Ms. Smalt went to Daytona Beach for the day. On their way back to Mr. Jackson's residence, they stopped at a restaurant in Daytona Beach for dinner. While at dinner, Ms. Smalt went to the restroom and Mr. Jackson began looking through Ms. Smalt's cell phone. Mr. Jackson found several phone calls from Mr. Rodriguez on the cell phone. After dinner, they began driving to Mr. Jackson's residence and Mr. Jackson began questioning Ms. Smalt about the phone calls from Mr. Rodriguez. They continued arguing until they arrived at Mr. Jackson's residence. Mr. Jackson and Ms. Smalt went inside the residence and were continuing to argue. Mr. Jackson then grabbed Ms. Smalt's cellphone and called Mr. Rodriguez to confront him. While Mr. Jackson is speaking with Mr. Rodriguez, Ms. Smalt attempts to get the phone away from Mr. Jackson. Mr. Jackson tries to keep her from getting the phone and slightly slaps Ms. Smalt on the face. After Mr. Jackson ends his phone call with Mr. Rodriguez, Mr. Jackson gives Ms. Smalt her phone back and tells her to leave. Ms. Smalt exits through the

back door of the residence and goes to her vehicle. Mr. Jackson follows her and gets in the passenger seat of the vehicle. Mr. Jackson and Ms. Smalt begin to talk and then Ms. Smalt tells Mr. Jackson that she wants to leave and asks him to exit the vehicle. Mr. Jackson exits the vehicle and begins to walk toward the front of the residence. Ms. Smalt remains in the backyard for a few minutes and then begins to back out to the front of the residence. As Ms. Smalt approaches Marietta St, Ms. Smalt observes an individual helping another individual up off the ground. Ms. Smalt backs up onto Marietta St and drives toward her residence located at 1050 Boylston St. When Ms. Smalt arrives home, she calls Mr. Jackson and he informs her of the incident. Ms. Smalt then drives back to Mr. Jackson's residence.

Ms. Smalt stated that she use to live with Mr. Jackson, but she moved back to her parents residence on Boylston St approximately two months ago. A domestic disturbance report was taken for the argument between Ms. Smalt and Mr. Jackson. (see case # 12-07-0224)

Mr. Jackson, Mr. Edwards and Ms. Smalt gave sworn written statements of the incident and Mr. Jackson wishes to prosecute.

Mr. Rodriguez was taken into custody at 0444 hrs and transported by Sr. Ofc. Thomas to the Leesburg Police Department for booking. Mr. Rodriguez's vehicle was driven to the Leesburg Police Department for crime scene processing.

A call out was made to the Criminal Investigations Division and Sr. Det. Green responded to the scene. Sr. Det. Green arrived on scene at approximately 0500 hrs and the scene was turned over to him. Sr. Det. Green processed and photographed the crime scene and he was assisted by Ofc. Blanton and Sr. Ofc. Wiley.

I responded to the Leesburg Police Department to write a PC Affidavit for Mr. Brown and to book Mr. Rodriguez.

At approximately 0553 hrs, Sgt. Stewart was informed by the Lake County Sheriffs Office that Mr. Brown was taken into custody and was transported to LCJ.

Booking paperwork on Mr. Brown was later delivered to LCJ by Ofc. Semmento.

Mr. Rodriguez was later transported to LCJ.

At Sgt. Stewart's request, Sgt. Mack and Ofc. Larue canvassed the neighborhood in an attempt to locate the original caller and any additional witnesses on the morning of 07/15/12, . Sgt. Mack and Ofc. Larue located a witness and the parties who originally called in the incident. (see Sgt. Mack's supplement for further)

July 15, 2012

On the morning of July 15, 2012, Ofc. Larue and I canvassed the neighborhood in an attempt to locate any further witnesses to this incident, to include the parties whom had called the police department to report the altercation.

I first made contact with Mr. Craig Zinke at 715 Marietta St, the residence directly to the south of the incident location. Mr. Zinke stated that sometime between 0100 and 0200hrs, he heard someone at the neighbor's residence. He stated that when he looked outside, he heard and saw two vehicles rapidly leaving, driving south on Marietta St, across the front of his home. He described the two vehicles as a Japanese style street motorcycle and an older model, light colored, long bed pickup truck. Mr. Zinke stated that he did not see the altercation that preceded.

Ofc. Larue then located and spoke with Ronald Moose and Randi Blankenship at the residence located at 711 Marietta St, the residence directly to the north of the incident location. He learned that Ms. Blankenship had been the one to call the Leesburg Police Department and report the altercation.

Ms. Blankenship advised that she had gone outside at sometime around midnight to smoke a cigarette. While she was outside, she heard the female at the neighboring residence yelling at someone. She stated that this was unusual as she had not heard their neighbors fighting before. She stated that several minutes later she hear several bangs and loud noises from outside. When she looked outside again, she saw that a silver truck and a motorcycle were parked in front of her residence. She stated that she looked over and beneath her neighbors truck and was able to see someone lift a cinder block and strike her neighbor with it while he was on the ground. She said that the fight continued for several minutes and she contacted the Leesburg Police Department. She described the two subjects who were attacking her neighbor as a Hispanic male and a white male. She stated that she stood on her front porch as she called the police department and began giving them the description of the vehicles. She stated that she believed the attackers must have heard her at this time, because they jumped into the truck and on the motorcycle and fled the area. She also said that the female neighbor then jumped into her white vehicle and left the area as well.

Mr. Moose corroborated Ms. Blankenship's statement, adding that at one point he heard someone say, "I didn't sleep with your girlfriend" and later heard another male ask, "Are you ok?"

Written statements were obtained from all three witnesses and this supplement was completed to be attached to the report.

On 7/15/12 at approximately 0052 hours I responded to 711 Marietta St in reference to four subjects fighting in the front yard.

Upon my arrival I made contact with Kenneth Warner, an independent witness. Mr. Warner advised at approximately 0045 hours he was walking north on Marietta St headed home. While in rout, he noticed three males fighting on what appeared to be the side walk. As he became closer to the individuals he noticed a white male was being forcefully held on the ground by larger in size hispanic male. While the other white male was standing above the two individuals on the ground with what appeared to be a construction type cinder block extended over his head as if he was going to throw it at the subject being held down. At this time Mr. Warren advised he stated "hey do you want me to call the police" to the male that was being held down on the ground. Upon hearing the voice of Mr. Warren the white male dropped the cinder block to the ground and the hispanic released the individual from his restraint. Mr. Warner advised the two individuals then proceed to run to a motorcycle and a pickup truck parked along the side of the rode way. Mr. Warren was able to advise the hispanic male entered the pickup truck and the white male mounted the motorcycle with both vehicles traveling southbound on Marietta. As the two vehicles drove away Mr. Warren called the police.

While getting the description of the two vehicles from Mr. Warren, a blue sports style motorcycle and a gold colored extended cab pickup truck. I noticed two vehicles matching that description headed northbound on Park Dr., I then transmitted a Bolo to responding officers in the area for the two vehicles now traveling eastbound on W Dixie Ave.

I then made contact with Justin Jackson, the victim, to check for injuries that needed medical treatment. Mr. Jackson sustained a laceration to his eyelash area and just beneath his eye, also some abrasions to his elbows, his left knee and his left ankle. While talking with Mr. Jackson he advised he and his girlfriend Megan Smalt (involved other) were in a verbal argument. Mr. Jackson advised the argument was over Ms. Smalt having relations with another male. Mr. Jackson advised at approximately 0030 hours he was walking up the steps to his front door when to males walked into his yard asking for MS. Smalt. Mr. Jackson then said he stated "she's at her house y'all can go check on her if you want". Mr. Jackson then advised the two male then started walking towards him demanding he come fight the both of them. Mr. Jackson advised he requested that the individuals to leave his yard, ignoring his request he advised they proceed toward him. Mr. Jackson advised he and the two males were standing approximately two to three feet away from each other when the hispanic male struck him in the face with a closed fist. After the first strike Mr. Jackson stated he couldn't advise what chain of events happened next or how he came to the position of laying with his back to the ground while being held by the hispanic male. Mr. Jackson advised he did take notice while on the ground of the white male standing above him with the cinder block as if he was going to hit him with it. At that time Mr. Jackson stated he heard someone asking if he needed it help and the two individuals leaving him and running. Mr. Jackson advised he then retreated into his residence.

Mr. Warren and Mr. Jackson gave written sworn statements.

On July 15, 2012 at approximately 12:50 a.m. I responded to 711 Marietta Street Leesburg Florida in reference to a battery in progress between 4 subjects. Upon my arrival Ofc. Blanton T24 advised that the suspect had just driven past Marietta Street on Dixie Avenue traveling east.

I left the scene there and went to attempt to locate the vehicle. Cpl. Sparkman T14 had located the vehicle (silver Chevrolet Silverado bearing Florida tag 7731GC) and performed a traffic stop in the area of Dixie Avenue and Rambo Street. I pulled in behind Cpl. Sparkman's patrol car and approached the passenger side of the truck. As the driver (later identified as Anthony Rodriguez) was speaking to Cpl. Sparkman I observed a black in color handgun lying in plain view in the front center of the truck on the floor.

The passenger window was down so I reached in, unlocked the door, quietly opened the door, quickly reached in and grabbed the gun. I removed the gun from the truck. The gun was a Springfield Arms 1911 .45 caliber serial number 106556. The hammer was in the cocked position; there was a full magazine, and a round in the chamber. Cpl. Sparkman asked Mr. Rodriguez to exit the truck at which time Cpl. Sparkman detained Mr. Rodriguez.

Mr. Rodriguez had blood on his shirt, abrasions on his elbows, and blood on his arms. I asked Mr. Rodriguez if he wanted to tell us his side of the story and he replied not right now. He stated that "the truth will come out in the end" and he did not say anything else to me. I placed Mr. Rodriguez in my marked patrol car while the investigation was being conducted and I read him his Miranda rights from a department issued card which I carry in my front right uniform shirt pocket. After I read each right to Mr. Rodriguez I asked him if he understood that right and each time he nodded his head in an up and down motion universally recognized as yes.

After Mr. Rodriguez was placed under arrest I photographed his truck, the gun, and his injuries which I turned in to be logged as evidence. I transported Mr. Rodriguez to the Leesburg Police Department where I turned him over to Ofc. Venta T22 for booking.

This is the extent of my involvement in this case.

On 7-15-12 at approximately 12:51 a.m. units responded to 711 Marietta St in reference to a physical fight in progress involving several subjects. Ofc Blanton arrived on scene and advised two suspect vehicles had left the scene goin South on Marrietta St. I was on 12 th St at Dixie Ave at this time. I observed a Chevrolet supercab truck and a motorcycle at the intersection of Park Drive and Dixie Ave. Ofc Blanton had just described via radio these exact vehicles as the vehicles containing suspects involved in the physical altercation. These two vehicles made a right turn onto Dixie Ave heading East at this time. I followed both vehicles waiting for a back up officer was able to catch up to us so could conduct a stop.

I conducted a traffic stop in the area of Rambo St and Dixie Ave on the Chevrolet truck FL tag 773 IGC. I made contact with the driver and immediately noticed a large amount of blood on his shirt and pants. Sgt Stewart had caught up with me and went ahead to stop the motorcycle. She stated the motorcycle fled from her as she tried to conduct a traffic stop on him. As I tried to interview the driver of my vehicle stop, Sr Ofc Thomas arrived to back me up. He approached on the passenger side of the truck and immediately noticed a semi auto handgun on the floor board in plain view. The gun was loaded and had the hammer back ready to fire. I ordered the driver out of the vehicle and placed him into handcuffs at this time. He was being detained at this time until we could find out what happened at the scene.

The driver of my traffic stop was identified as Anthony M. Rodriguez DOB 6-09-87. I attempted to find out from him what had happened but he refused to talk stating " it will all come out in the end." He refused any medical treatment due to some obvious injuries he had on him. We stood by as Sgt Stewart went back to the scene to find out exactly what had occurred. After a period of time, She advised via radio there would be charges against my driver. He was placed in the back of Sr Ofc Thomas's car at this time.

Due to circumstances involving the other suspect on the motorcycle, we stood by on scene for an extended period of time so the investigation involving LCSO and our units on scene of the incident could be conducted. While on the scene of my traffic stop, Sr Ofc Thomas read Rodriguez his miranda warnings. He agreed to talk to me and explained the entire incident to me.

Rodriguez stated the girl involved in this incident called him earlier on this date and was extremely upset at a male who was present with her at this time. While she was talking with Rodriguez, this male slapped her across her face. Rodriguez stated he went to the area of the incident scene to check on her well being when he was confronted by the male at the front sidewalk of a residence on Marrietta St. This male approached Rodriguez and swung at him hitting

PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared VENTA, ALBERTO L. (1062) who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 15 day of July, 2012, in Lake County, Florida, the defendant did:

On 07/15/12 at approximately 0051 hrs, units responded to 713 Marietta St. in reference to a battery in progress. The caller advised dispatch that there were several subjects outside fighting at that location. When asked how many, the caller said approximately 4 subjects. The caller also advised dispatch that there was a silver in color Chevy truck and a motorcycle in the yard. The caller advised dispatch that she did not see any weapons.

Ofc. Blanton arrived on scene and made contact with a witness who advised Ofc. Blanton that the Chevy truck and the motorcycle headed south bound on Marietta St. and turned right. Ofc. Blanton looked toward W. Dixie Ave and he observed the truck and motorcycle heading east bound on W. Dixie Ave. Ofc. Blanton advised units of the direction of travel over the main police radio channel.

Ofc. Blanton asked the witness what happened and he stated the following:

The witness was walking north bound on Marietta St and observed 3 individuals fighting in front of 713 Marietta St. As the witness approached the individuals, he saw that two subjects were on top of another individual, repeatedly striking him. As the witness got closer to the subjects, he observed the defendant holding the victim down on the ground. The co-defendant stood up and picked up a cinder block that was lying on the ground next to them. The co-defendant raised the cinder block in his hands about chest high. The co-defendant then held the cinder block over the victims head as if he were going to hit him on the head with it. The witness called out to the victim and asked if he needed help. The co-defendant and defendant heard and then saw the witness. The co-defendant dropped the cinder block on the ground. The co-defendant ran and got on the motorcycle and the defendant ran and got into the Chevy truck. The co-defendant and defendant fled the scene south bound on Marietta St.

It was determined that the witness was an independent witness who did not have any affiliation with either party involved in the incident.

Ofc. Blanton then made contact with the victim who stated the following:

The victim was walking up the steps to the front door of his residence when he heard someone yell at him. The victim looked toward the street and observed a gold or silver in color Chevy Silverado and a motorcycle parked on the street and the co-defendant and defendant were walking toward his residence. The defendant asked the victim where the victim's girlfriend was and the victim replied that she was in her vehicle in the backyard and was leaving the residence. The victim walked toward the co-defendant and defendant and they began to argue in the front yard. The defendant then punched the victim and they all began to fight. The co-defendant broke away from the fight and

Ofc. Blanton asked the witness what happened and he stated the following:




